\$20 for a chicken some layers available.

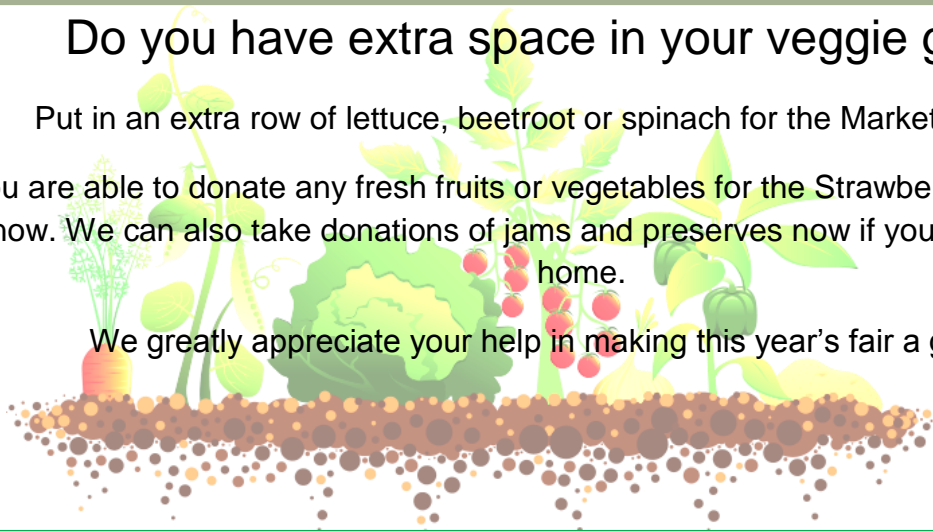
See Christie Evans, Rm 13 to order and pay for your new pet.
