**\$20 for a chicken** some layers available.

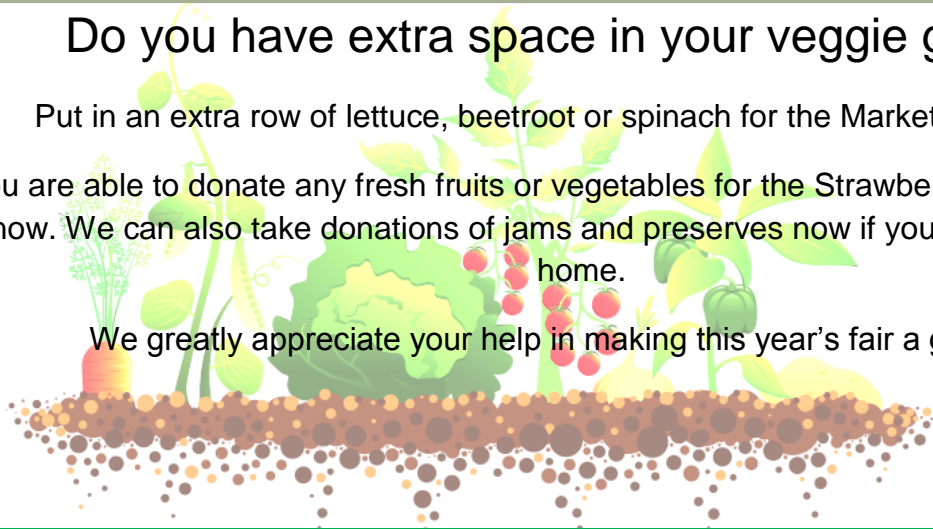

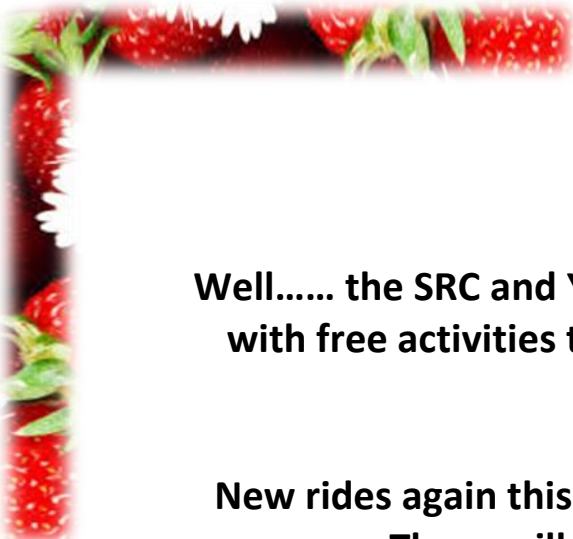
