Hats: SunSmart hats (broadbrim/bucket/legionnaires) must be worn every day when the UV is 3 or above. No hat, no outdoor play.

When on excursions, we will provide the children with matching OSHC hats, but only for the duration of the excursion.

Late collection/early arrivals outside of these times children will incur a fee of \$1 per minute per child.

Booking

To secure a place for your child/ren simply book a Vacation Care Casual Booking session via the OWNA app. If you wish to book a half-day session, you will need to email the service to request either an AM (7-12) or PM (12:30-6:15) session.

Please be advised that, by booking your child/ren for a session, you are providing consent for the child to be involved in all of the activities included in the program.

Please be aware that bookings will be subject to the service's Priority of Access Guidelines. It is possible for us to be fully booked, but waiting lists are available on OWNA.

New 2024:

Receptions starting Term 1 2024 can attend Vacation Care from January 8th onwards.

Fees

The cost of Vacation Care is \$54 for a full day session, or on incursions parents can request a half day option for \$34 via email. This price may be reduced if families have applied for Centrelink Child Care Subsidies.

Please be advised that Centrelink will only provide Child Care Subsidies between a child's first and last day of physical attendance. If they are absent for 14 weeks Centrelink will refuse to pay their portion of your fees, and you will be belatedly charged.

Cancellations / Absences

Any cancellations requested in writing prior to the following dates will be processed free of charge:

- 1. For December bookings, the final date is 3/12/22.
- 2. For January bookings, the final date is 22/12/22.

Cancellations requested after this date will be charged full fees unless another family on the waiting list is willing to take their place.

Alternatively, a medical certificate can cover the charge for a family as long as it is received the same week as the absence (prior to service close at 6:15pm on Friday for Centrelink weekend processing).

If your child becomes COVID-19 Positive: they cannot attend while they are contagious, or if they show any symptoms. Evidence of a Positive COVID case within the household can be used in lieu of a medical certificate to waive all fees.

We ask all families to keep their child/ren home if they are unwell. If a child shows signs of illness, families will be contacted immediately and the child sent home.

Health Needs / Medication

Medication Paperwork— a Medication Authority, Action Plan, and a Risk Minimisation/Communication Plan—must be completed for every child with a medical condition attending Vacation Care.

All medication must be supplied to the centre prior to the child's attendance. It must be in the original packaging with the pharmacy label stating the child's name. Parent/carer's must sign all medication in through the OWNA Medication Record. Children diagnosed with Anaphylaxis, Allergies, Asthma, or Diabetes must bring their medication/s or the child cannot attend.

<u>Meals</u>

Children will need to make sure that they bring their recess, lunch, and water bottle. We will provide breakfast (7 - 8am), afternoon tea (3:15pm), and late snack (4:45pm).

If a child does not bring a water bottle to OSHC, they will be supplied with a disposable one and a \$1 charge will be applied to your account. If your child does not have recess/lunch, we will supply food at a cost.




